



# Squared Hearts

This square makes use of corner to corner (C2C) techniques, using dc stitches. This grid is best followed by beginning with one of the bottom corners.

**Skill: Beginner/Intermediate**

**US Terms**

**Materials:**

A small amount of worsted weight yarn in two colors

h hook (5.00 mm)

Yarn needle for weaving in ends.

**Gauge:** Final square measures 7" across at completion.

**Stitches:**

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Chain (ch)

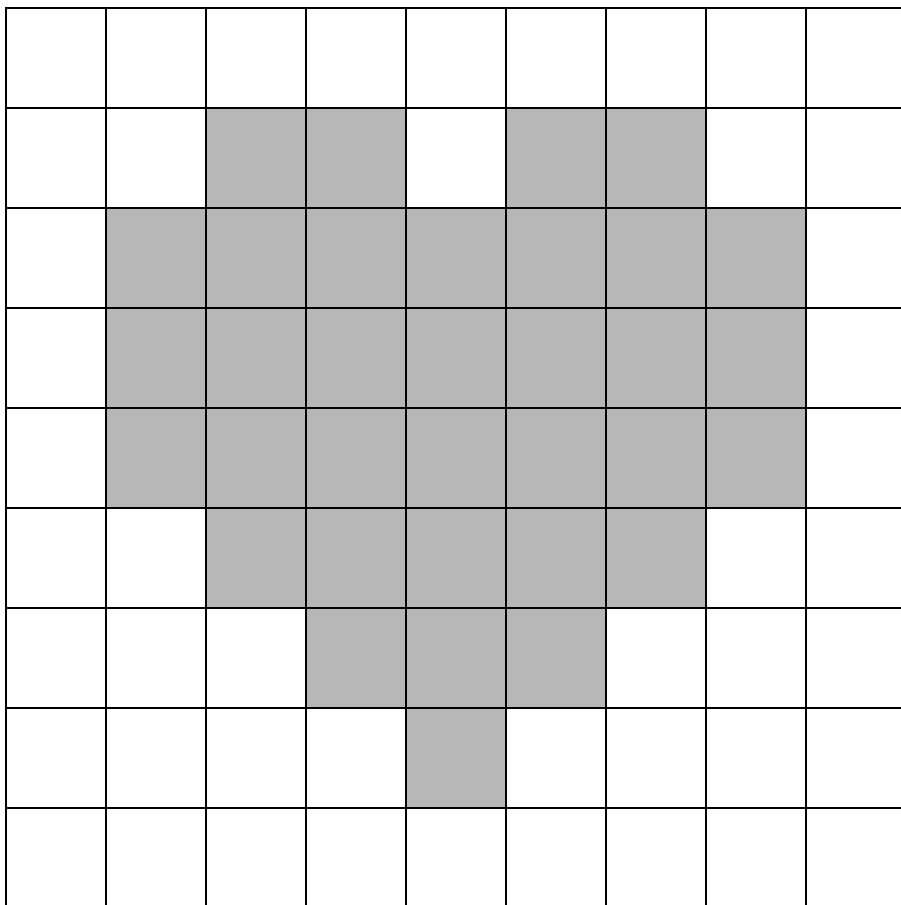
Single Crochet (sc)

Double Crochet (dc)

**Notes:** You must be familiar with C2C techniques to complete this square. This pattern provides the grid and edging instructions. This is not a tutorial for C2C crochet.



### Squared Hearts



Complete the grid using C2C (corner to corner) techniques. Once completed, continue using the background color to sc evenly around each side: ch 1, 2 sc in each block, 1 sc between blocks. In corner blocks, 2 sc along the block, ch 2, 2 sc along the other side of the block, and continue the same pattern of 1 sc between blocks, 2 sc in each block. This will result in 26 sc stitches on each side.
